

COVERED ELECTRONICS

There is currently a state-wide problem with TV recycling but they are still being accepted at Goodwill Donation centers:

Rt. 130 in Willingboro, Rt. 73 in Maple Shade, Rt. 206 in Bordentown or Rt. 38 in Lumberton.

These sites take non-working TVs and computers for recycling, not reuse. The dropoff point is located around the back of the Donation Center (do not bring your items into the store).

If you are not a business or non-profit, you can bring tvs and computers to the County Resource Recovery Complex, with these conditions:

- No more than 2 TVs and or computer monitors will be accepted per resident (no businesses or non-profits). Proof of ID is required.
- Residents will be charged \$20/unit for more than 2 of these items.

Another option is Best Buy for TVs 32" or less, but they are charging a fee of \$25/unit.
